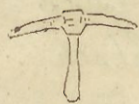


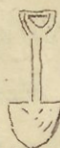

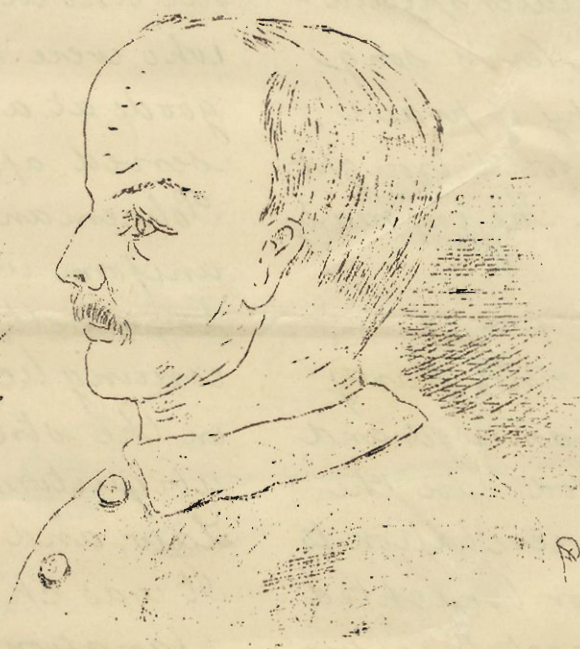

ant Republican Caucus.

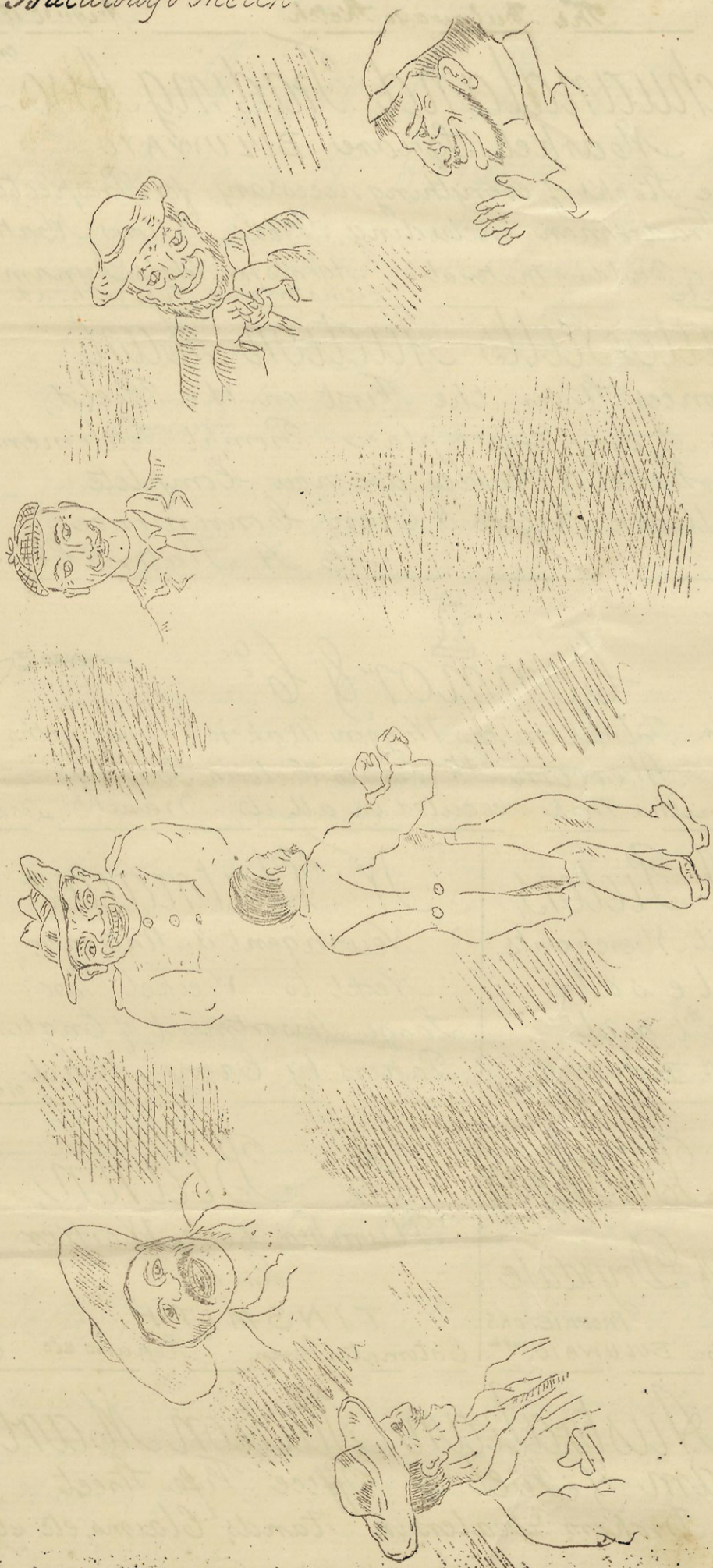

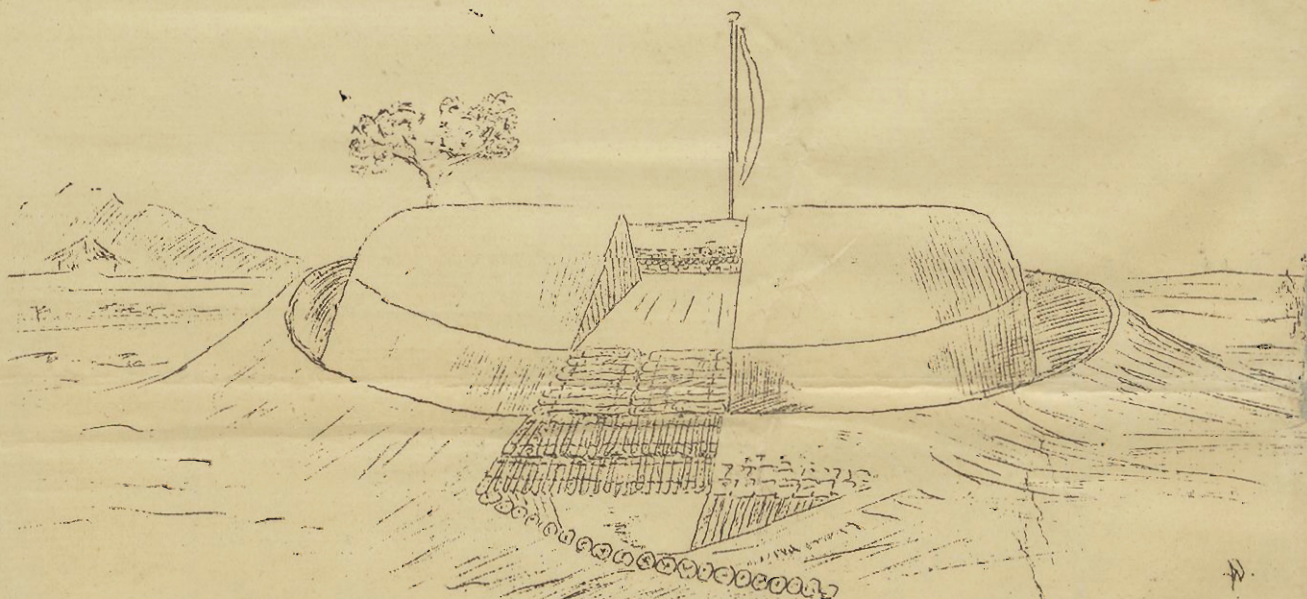
